The New England Indoor Open consists of twenty scoring ends of three arrows each. All adults, youth compound and all Cadet and Junior recurve archers will shoot at the 40 cm target face. Inner 10-ring scoring applies to all release divisions. Archers may choose either the single or multi-spot target face. All cub and bowman recurve youth archers will shoot the 60 cm target face.

Note age divisions: Bowman through calendar year of 12th birthday; Cub through calendar year of 14th birthday; Cadet through calendar year of 17th birthday; Junior through calendar year of 20th birthday.

Fees

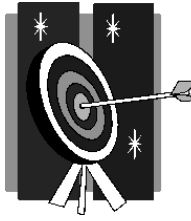
- A. Pre-registration fees before February 7th :
 - Youth Classes: \$25.00; Adult Classes: \$30.00
- B. Late registrations (received after February 8th):
 - Youth Classes: \$30.00; Adult Classes: \$35.00

Equipment

- A. NFAA equipment rules apply to the following classes:
 - Olympic Bow, adult and youth; Compound Bow Release, adult and youth
 - Barebow (Men and Women Compete together, and youth compete together)
- B. Bowhunter Class rules:
 - Minimum of 40#; sights may not be moved during competition; maximum stabilizer length of 12"; no magnifying scopes can be used; archers shooting release aids and archers shooting with fingers compete together
- C. Traditional Class rules:
 - Recurve or longbow; minimum 40# for men, 35# for women; split finger only (no "gun barreling"); no stabilizers; any style arrow or arrow rest; Adults compete together and Youth compete together

Competition Rules

Scorecards must be picked up fifteen minutes prior to your shooting time. There will be two official practice ends. Archers may shoot as many as six arrows per practice end. Official scoring will consist of twenty ends of three arrows each. Archers shooting the bottom targets must shoot first; shooting position and order of shooting will be switched after ten ends of scoring. All arrows must be scored before any arrows are withdrawn within your shooting group. On a single spot face, if an archer shoots more than three arrows during an end, the three arrows with the lowest values will be scored; on a multi-spot face, if an archer shoots more than three arrows during an end, the three arrows with the lowest values will be scored, but no more than one arrow per face may be scored. Archers may neither give nor receive coaching while on the shooting line. Archers must step off the shooting line to receive coaching. Coaches must remain behind the shooting line at all times. Three signatures are required on each scorecard. PLEASE CHECK ALL MATH AND SCORES on your scorecard. Once scorecards have been turned in to tournament officials, the scores are final.
